


COVID-19 MEASURES

Hyve India, part of Hyve Group, puts health and safety as its first priority in all exhibitions that it organizes following the COVID-19 pandemic.

SOCIAL DISTANCING

- Event arrival, access and registration procedures for exhibitors, contractors and visitors are being planned by the event organizers and venue. As much as possible, this process will be contactless and staff in frequent close contact with a large number of people will be protected behind screens or will be wearing necessary personal protective equipment.
- **Final certificate for COVID-19 vaccination or negative RT-PCR report is mandatory, maximum 72 hrs. old before entering the venue premises. Entry is strictly prohibited without final certificate for COVID-19 vaccination or negative RT-PCR report.***
- Depending on crowd density expectations and gangway widths, one-way systems may be introduced in certain gangways or across the event. Where these are in place, the system will be clearly indicated.
- On-site service desk systems and facilities are being reviewed and will be protected by screens/barriers where possible. Physical distancing protocols will also apply. Measures are under constant review and any other necessary precautions/ systems will be communicated to you prior to the event.
- Any areas where queuing is required around the venue will be managed with signage, floor markings, rope and post/tensator barriers where applicable.

HYGIENE

- Hand washing facilities will be available at the venue in the usual locations, and alcohol based hand sanitizer will be provided by the venue and event organizers within venue concourses, hall entrances and other high traffic areas (such as toilets, catering areas, show features etc.)
- General cleaning services will be increased at the exhibition venue and all surfaces (door handles, tables, elevator buttons, escalators etc.) will be cleaned at least twice a day during the show, using special disinfectant solutions with a special focus on the cleansing of restrooms.
- Commercial overnight deep cleaning services provided for the exhibition area will be increased and disinfection will be carried out for the next day.

WEARING MASK

- People not wearing a face mask will not be admitted to the exhibition venue, as per government guidelines
- All staff members coming to the exhibition area must bring their personal protective equipment (face mask, gloves, etc.). In case of the shortage, a supply of protective gears will be available at the exhibition venue to provide the necessary equipment.
- There will be designated staff tasked with enforcing the hygiene measures, and warnings will be issued to those found in breach to take remedial action or exit the premises



GENERAL MEASURES

- Signs will be available throughout the exhibition area to remind people to maintain the necessary hygiene standards and physical distance.
- Regular announcements will be made in the exhibition area and will act as a reminder of the use of face masks while maintaining the physical distance as part of the general hygiene rules.
- Additional security staff will ensure measures are followed.
- Visitors under the age of 16 will not be admitted to the exhibition venue as part of general measures.
- B2B Meeting and Event/Food Areas, Event Organizer Office, Press Room, Info and Registration Desks will be designed considering physical distancing and hygiene rules.
- All visitors will be subject to body temperature screening at the exhibition entrances, in line with government requirements.
- People with a body temperature of above 99 degrees (37.2 Celsius) and show the symptoms of the disease will be taken to the Emergency Health Services (isolation room & dedicated ambulance).
- **Final certificate for COVID-19 vaccination or negative RT-PCR report is mandatory, maximum 72 hrs. old before entering the venue premises. Entry is strictly prohibited without final certificate for COVID-19 vaccination or negative RT-PCR report.***
- Hyve continues to monitor the situation very closely, work with local authorities and will follow up with all parties as the situation develops.
